CURRENT STATUS:

(7/8/2016) Project complete June 2016.

WHAT IS THIS PROJECT GOING TO ACCOMPLISH?

The scope of this project is a city wide traffic control signal safety project to add retro-reflective signal back plates, pedestrian countdown heads, and upgrade to 12" Led signal heads for all City signalized intersections requiring these upgrades.

Design and Bid-Spring-Summer 2015

Construction-Summer-Fall 2015

HOW WILL THIS PROJECT BE FUNDED?

This project is funded through the Federal Highway Administration's Highway Safety Improvement Program. Funds are available through a competitive grant process requiring local match funds of 7.34% (Federal share is 92.66%). Applications are made to the Idaho Transportation Department and successful grants are administered by the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) for the State. The City was successful in securing a grant in the amount of \$85,000 for this work. The Federal share is 9.266%, or \$78,760 and the City share is 7.34% or \$6, 240.
