



Thain/Powers/14th St. Intersection Improvement Project

CURRENT STATUS: (11/10/2016) The contractor is scheduled to start in March 2017.

WHAT IS THIS PROJECT GOING TO ACCOMPLISH?

The intersection of Thain Rd/14th St/Powers Ave is located in the southeast part of the city on one of the primary north/south routes. The five-legged geometry of the intersection is unusual and it actually functions as two separate, but closely spaced intersections. Improvements will relieve congestion and improve safety.

 Preliminary Design – April 2012
 Categorical Exclusion – April 30, 2015
 Final Design – Winter 2016
 Bidding – Spring 2016
 Construction – Spring 2017

HOW WILL THIS PROJECT BE FUNDED?

Initial funding for the concept plans and property purchase came from property and gas tax. The balance for preliminary design through construction comes from a Federal Highway Funding Agreement with Idaho Transportation Department. 92.66% federal and 7.34% local (property tax).
