



2016 Downtown Infrastructure Repair & Replacement Project (IRRP)

CURRENT STATUS:

(9/13/2016) The project is on budget and on schedule. Weekly project meetings will be open to the public and planned to be held 9:00 AM Thursday mornings at the Public Works Dept. located at 215 D St. Suite B.

WHAT IS THIS PROJECT GOING TO ACCOMPLISH?

When completed this fall, the 2016 IRRP will have constructed approximately 2,200 feet of water line, 4,000 feet of storm drainage pipe, 22 storm drainage inlets, 2,100 feet of curb, 1,400 square yards of sidewalk, 9,800 square yards of asphalt pavement and base, 1,600 feet of fiber conduit, 15 ADA ramps, and sanitary sewer point repairs in 9th Street, F Street, Idaho Street, New Sixth Street, 11th Street, and Adams Lane.
