



RESIDENTIAL YARD WASTE SELF-HAUL GUIDELINES

Updated July 8, 2016

Residential self-haulers may dispose yard waste free of charge at the city contracted compost facility with their current city sanitation bill, or county tax assessment with sanitation fee shown.

If you do not have your current city sanitation bill, you may obtain a copy at City Hall.

If you do not have your current city sanitation bill at the time of disposal, you may be responsible for your own disposal charges.

COMMERCIAL ACCOUNTS AND COMMERCIAL SELF-HAULERS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN DISPOSAL CHARGES.

PLASTIC BAGS – disposable plastic bags may be used during the months of November through March.

'KRAFT' PAPER BAGS – disposable Kraft paper bags may be used year round. These bags are available at retail outlet stores.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIAL – grass clippings, leaves, tree and shrub trimmings, garden waste, Christmas trees, and lawn and garden bark may be disposed without limitation to volume.

SOD/DIRT – sod is not acceptable.

TREE/SHRUB TRIMMINGS – Limbs, trunks, and stumps larger than 6" in diameter and/or 6' in length are not acceptable.

ROOTS/DIRT – tree/shrub roots and shrubs with roots attached are not acceptable.

Loads of noxious weeds are not acceptable material.
