NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED AMBULANCE SERVICE FEE INCREASE
FOR FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING 10/01/22 (FY 2023)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lewiston City Council will conduct a ***public hearing*** on ***Monday, July 25, 2022***. The meeting will begin at ***6:00 p.m.*** at the ***Lewiston City Library, 2nd Floor, 411 D Street, Lewiston, Idaho, 83501***. The purpose of the public hearing is to take public testimony regarding the proposed ambulance fees and to explain the reasons for the increases.

Lewiston's City Council is considering Ambulance Service Fee Increases for Fiscal Year 2023, which will become effective October 1, 2022. This increase creates additional funds for maintenance and operation of the City's Emergency Medical Services Division, which provides ambulance service to both Lewiston and non-Lewiston residents.

Resolution 2022-28 is proposed to modify Ambulance Service Fees for the following:

- Basic Life Support - \$468 to \$480
- Advanced Life Support Transport - \$728 to \$746
- Advanced Life Support Treat and No Transport - \$200 to \$205
- Multiple Patients - \$234 to \$240
- Out-of-Area Transfers - \$468 to \$480 and \$728 to \$746
- Local Non-Emergency Inter-facility, Home and Medical Flight Connection
 - Basic Life Support - \$260 to \$267
 - Advanced Life Support - \$442 to \$453
- Second Attendant - \$208 to \$213
- Mileage (per patient transport mile) - \$11.44 to \$11.73
- Oxygen - \$37 to \$38
- Extrication - \$130 to \$133
- Medical Convenience or Standby Time (per hour) - \$104 to \$107
- Ambulance Special Event Standby (per hour) - \$104 to \$130
- Single EMS Provider Special Event Standby per hour - \$47 to \$65
