Order Terminating Local Disaster Emergency

WHEREAS, the health and safety of all citizens of the City of Lewiston is of the utmost importance;

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2023, a breach/failure of a water holding reservoir located near 16th Avenue in the City of Lewiston resulted in the flooding of multiple homes and businesses and compromised potable water for over Twenty-Four Thousand (24,000) City of Lewiston residents, which resulted in an emergency Boil Water Alert Order to be issued by the City of Lewiston and a Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency to be issued by the Mayor of the City of Lewiston, which Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency was recorded with the Nez Perce County Recorder as Instrument No. 905244 (hereafter "Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency");

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2023, the Boil Water Alert Order was lifted for some areas within the City of Lewiston, but the remaining areas within the City of Lewiston remained subject to the Boil Water Alert Order;

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2023, the Lewiston City Council passed Resolution 2023-8, consenting to the continuance of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency beyond seven (7) days of its inception, if necessary, in accordance with Idaho Code § 46-1011, which was recorded with the Nez Perce County Recorder as Instrument No. 905426;

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2023, the Boil Water Alert Order was lifted for the remaining areas within the City of Lewiston and, thus, fully lifted; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor now desires to terminate the local disaster emergency that was the subject of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency, pursuant to Idaho Code § 46-1011.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Daniel G. Johnson, Mayor of the City of Lewiston, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Idaho Code § 46-1011, do hereby order as follows:


- 1. The local disaster emergency that was the subject of the Declaration of Local Disaster Emergency is hereby terminated.
- 2. This Order shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Nez Perce County Recorder, in accordance with Idaho Code § 46-1011.
- 3. This Order shall be in full force and effect immediately.


